WHEREAS, the revisions to San Benito County Ordinance No. 781766, codified as Section 34.5018-148.121.003.01 et seq. of <u>Chapter 18</u>Title 21 (Zoning OrdinanceBuilding and Engineering) of the San Benito County Code, revising <u>Hillside DevelopmentInclusionary</u> <u>Housing</u> Regulations, will bring the Ordinance more in compliance is consistent with the General Plan and will better achieve the goals, policies, and objectives in the General Plan; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Hillside Ordinance will continue to protect the aesthetic resource of hillsides while not prohibiting hillside development; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Hillside Ordinance will balance the interests of the community and property owner, without imposing arbitrary limits on height, size or other design characteristics, but rather to ensure that each lot is developed in accordance with its unique location, topography, and vegetation, and to incorporate reasonable hillside mitigation measures, such as landscaping, building material(s) and color palettes and which ensure the property owner(s) of the reasonable use and enjoyment of their property; and<u>on</u> June 15, 2016, at a duly noticed and regularly scheduled public hearing, the Planning Commission heard and considered all oral and written testimony relating to the Inclusionary Housing Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the County of San Benito finds that the revision to Ordinance No. 781 qualifies for a Class 7 categorical exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act_(CEQA Guideline 15307) as an action by a regulatory agency for protection of natural resources<u>WHEREAS</u>, amending the Inclusionary Housing Requirements will further enhance the public welfare, benefit the property being developed, assure compatibility between future housing development and the housing units affordable to persons of very low, low, and moderate income, ensure that remaining developable land in the County is utilized in a manner consistent with state and local housing policies and needs, and provide more flexibility to the County in providing affordable housing; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that based on the evidence in the record, the Planning Commission of the County of San Benito hereby finds as follows:

Finding 1: That amending the San Benito County Inclusionary Housing Ordinance <u>is not a</u> project under the California Environmental Quality Act and could not have a significant effect on the environment pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).

Evidence: It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the adoption of the proposed Inclusionary Housing Ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment, in that the Ordinance affects only the affordability of residences constructed in the County of San Benito and does not contain provisions modifying development, design, or construction of residences.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the County of San Benito reviewed the proposed revisions to Ordinance 781 at a regularly scheduled public hearings held on March 2, March 16, April 6, April 25, May 4, and May 18, 2005, October 18, 2006, and April 18, May 2, May 16, August 29, September 19, October 3, October 17, November 15, and December 5, 2007; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Planning Commission of the County of San Benito that it hereby finds as follows: *NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED* tThat, based on the foregoing findings and determinations, the Planning Commission of the County of San Benito hereby declares its recommendation to the Board of Supervisors that the Board of Supervisorsto approve the revisions to Ordinance No. 78166 by adopting the proposed Ordinance attached hereto and changes includorporated herein by reference as in Exhibit 1.
