A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN BENITO OPPOSING PROPOSITION 64

WHEREAS, provisions of Proposition 64 will threaten public safety and endanger thousands of California residents through increased impaired driving; and,

WHEREAS, marijuana is associated with many detrimental health effects, such as respiratory illnesses, problems with learning and memory, increased heart rate, and impaired coordination; and,

WHEREAS, Proposition 64 is opposed by the California Hospital Association, the California Police Chiefs Association, the California State Sheriff's Association, and the California District Attorneys Association; and,

WHEREAS, Proposition 64 would lead to greater youth access to marijuana; and,

WHEREAS, legalization of marijuana has proven to be a dramatic burden on health and public safety officials in States where it has been legalized; and,

WHEREAS, Proposition 64 would greatly increase State Bureaucracy in order to develop rules to regulate recreational marijuana;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Benito County Board of Supervisors opposes the passage of California State Proposition 64 on the November 8, 2016, ballot.
