WHEREAS, the San Benito County Office of Education has established of goal that all students meet grade level English language literacy standards by grade 3;

WHEREAS, the San Benito County Probation Department seeks to increase rehabilitative opportunities for justice involved youth, adults, and families in San Benito County, and literacy is a key component in this effort;

WHEREAS, the Footsteps2Brilliance Academic Language classroom has demonstrated positive vocabulary and English language outcomes to counter the "30 million word gap", and supports the "Model Innovation City" program to coordinate and leverage support for community-wide application of its Early Learning Mobile Technology Platform which has been implemented with success in the City of Palmdale, Napa County, and Revere, Massachusetts;

WHEREAS, with the support and assistance of the San Benito County Free Library and the San Benito County Probation Department, the San Benito County Office of Education has implemented the Footsteps2Brilliance Academic Language classroom and community pilot program, and has entered into an agreement for the Footsteps2Brilliance Early Learning Mobile Technology Platform for San Benito County children and families to access its academic vocabulary and English language acquisition program outside of the classroom to counter the "30 million work gap" from any location;
