17 WHEREAS, in order to be eligible for funding under the Juvenile Crime Enforcement  
18 Accountability Challenge Grant Program, the County is required to establish a  
19 multiagency Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council, pursuant to section 749.22 of the  
20 California Welfare and Institutions Code, to develop and implement a comprehensive,  
21 multiagency plan that identifies the resources and strategies for providing an effective  
22 continuum of county-based responses for the prevention, intervention, supervision,  
23 treatment and incarceration of male and female juvenile offenders, as described in section  
24 749.22(a)-(e); and

25 WHEREAS, section 749.22 specifies the membership of a multiagency Juvenile Justice  
26 Coordinating Council to include, at a minimum, the following:

- 27     • the Chief Probation Officer as Chair;
- 28     • one representative from each of the following:
  - the District Attorney's Office;
  - the Public Defender's Office;
  - the Sheriff's Office;
  - the Board of Supervisors;
  - the Department of Social Services;
  - the Department of Mental Health;
  - a community-based drug and alcohol program;
  - a City Police Department;
  - the County Office of Education or a school district;
  - an at-large community representative; and

- 1       • representatives from nonprofit community-based organizations providing services  
2       to minors; and

3       WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors previously established the San Benito County  
4       Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council, and has appointed members satisfying the criteria  
5       set forth in section 749.22 from time to time; and

6       WHEREAS, new members satisfying the criteria set forth in section 749.22 need to be  
7       appointed to fill positions that have been vacated.

8       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San  
9       Benito, that it hereby appoints Chief Probation Officer Joseph A. Frontella, Jr. as the  
10      Chair of the San Benito County Juvenile Justice Coordination Council.

11      BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Benito,  
12      that it hereby appoints the following individuals as members of the San Benito County  
13      Juvenile Justice Coordination Council:

26      BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Benito,  
27      that it hereby authorizes the Chief Probation Officer to sign San Benito County's annual  
28      application for its allocation of State funding, and submit it to the State of California, for  
and on behalf of the County of San Benito.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Benito,  
2 that it hereby declares its intention that the County will adhere to the requirements of the  
3 Board of Corrections and all conditions specified in any appropriate grant agreements  
4 entered into with the State of California, regarding the expenditure of State funds  
received, as described in the annual application.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Benito,  
6 that it hereby declares its intention that the County participate in the collection of  
7 research data and participate in program evaluation activities associated with the grant  
award, as described in its plan and in section 749.22 of the Welfare and Institutions Code.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Benito,  
9 that it hereby declares its intention, in the event that the County receives a funding  
10 allocation grant acceptable to the Board of Supervisors, that the County will enter into an  
11 agreement with the State of California relative to the expenditure of funds and program  
12 implementation and evaluation, by not later than August 31 of each year, and that it  
13 hereby authorizes the Chief Probation Officer to sign related contracts, amendments, or  
14 extensions with the State of California, for and on behalf of the County of San Benito,  
following the Board of Supervisors' acceptance of the grant funds, without returning for  
further approval from the Board of Supervisors.
