Registration Transfer Permit Application

- **Commitment: 15 years of in-County landfill capacity at John Smith Road Landfill**
- **Request: Contractor requests to dispose a portion of this in-County waste stream at an alternate landfill at Contractor's sole cost (consistent with 2nd Amendment to Contract)**
- **Purpose: To provide San Benito County with at least 15 years of disposal capacity independent of remaining permitted airspace at John Smith Road Landfill (Current 15 year in-County capacity will be reached in May '22 – without this action)**
- Today we seek Board of Supervisors approval for County staff to sign and submit application for registration transfer permit to CalRecycle
 - 30 day permit application with CalRecycle requires no CEQA for this 99.9 ton per day transfer station
- Upon issuance of permit, contractor returns to Board in March '22 for approval of transfer station alternative
- Transfer station to be located at John Smith Landfill
- Transfer station implemented only after out-of-County flow to John Smith Landfill has ceased
- Transfer station would include 5 transfer trucks leaving (and returning to) the landfill each weekday, but due to the absence of out-of-County traffic, there would be a **net decrease in traffic at the landfill**
- Transfer station alternative is a **contingent plan** in the event that we do not receive landfill expansion entitlement over the next several months
