## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-17**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN BENITO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN BENITO AND SAN BENITO COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION (DSA)

WHEREAS, the San Benito Deputy Sheriff's Association (DSA), is the recognized bargaining unit for certain identified job classes within San Benito County (County), and

WHEREAS, the County and the San Benito Deputy Sheriff's Association (DSA) is required under the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act to meet and confer in good faith regarding wages, hours, and other terms and conditions of employment; and

WHEREAS, the County, and the San Benito Deputy Sheriff's Association (DSA), having met and conferred in good faith, reached a total tentative agreement on a successor collective bargaining agreement for the DSA Unit; and

WHEREAS, the successor collective bargaining agreement has been ratified by the membership of the San Benito Deputy Sheriff's Association (DSA) and the Board of Supervisors is required to ratify the successor collective bargaining agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the San Benito County Board of Supervisors hereby enacts the following:

- Approve the Memorandum of Understanding with the San Benito Deputy Sheriff's Association (DSA), and direct the Chief Negotiators, Chair of the Board of Supervisors, and the Deputy County Administrative Officer to sign the Memorandum of Understanding;
- 2. Authorize the County Administrative Officer to implement the terms and conditions as outlined in the MOU.
- 3. Authorize the County Administrative Officer or his/her designee to make any technical edits as later identified.
- 4. Direct the County Administrative Officer to take such further action as may be necessary to immediately implement the MOU and the direction of the Board set forth herein.
