6 **WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter  
7 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in  
8 April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls  
9 statewide; and

9 **WHEREAS**, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure  
10 the residents of San Benito County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in the  
11 community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors must adopt by resolution a list of projects  
12 proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation  
13 Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of  
14 each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project’s completion, and the  
15 estimated useful life of the improvement; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the County prepared a list of projects, attached hereto and incorporated  
16 herein by reference as Exhibit A, proposed to receive RMRA funding; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the County will receive an estimated \$2,471,294.00 in RMRA funding in  
18 Fiscal Year 2022-2023 from SB 1; and

19 **WHEREAS**, this is the sixth year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and will  
20 enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects,  
21 safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and  
22 mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible  
23 without SB 1; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the County has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input  
24 into the County’s transportation priorities and the SB 1 project list; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1  
26 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective  
27 projects that also meet the community’s priorities for transportation investment; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain and rehabilitate six(6)  
28 road sections throughout the County this year and additional similar projects into the  
future; and

1 WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment  
2 found that the County's roads are in "poor" condition and this revenue will help increase  
3 the overall quality of the County's road system and will bring County roads into "good"  
4 condition over the next decade; and

4 WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in the County's roads  
5 infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets  
6 infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have  
7 significant positive co-benefits statewide.

7 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San  
8 Benito, State of California, that it hereby makes the following findings and orders:

- 9 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct;
- 10 2. The SB 1 project list attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as  
11 Exhibit A is hereby adopted for Fiscal Year 2022-2023;
- 12 3. The previously proposed and adopted projects included in the SB 1 project list  
13 (Exhibit A) will utilize Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation  
14 Account revenues in their delivery; and
- 15 4. By relisting these projects, the Board of Supervisors hereby reaffirms to the public  
16 and the State its intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and  
17 Rehabilitation Account revenues.
