A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN BENITO COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO APPROVE A
RECOMMENDATION TO REDUCE IN-COUNTY WASTE
TIPPING FEE RATES AT THE JOHN SMITH ROAD LANDFILL

Resolution 2018 -

WHEREAS, the County of San Benito owns property located on John Smith Road, known as the John Smith Road Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Benito has entered into a Landfill Operating Agreement ("Agreement") with Waste Solutions Group of San Benito, LLC ("Waste Solutions"), a wholly owned subsidiary of Waste Connections, Inc., whereby the Waste Solutions Group of San Benito operates the John Smith Road Landfill for on behalf of the County of San Benito; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that the County has the sole right to set and adjust the In-County Waste Tipping Fees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors last adjusted In-County landfill waste tipping fee rates on July 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Landfill Ad hoc Committee met on March 15, 2018 to consider alternatives regarding reducing the In-County tipping fee rates at the John Smith Landfill and decided that it is important to lower the In-County waste tipping fee rates to be more equitable with the rates that adjoining (out-of-county) communities pay; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has directed that the following In-County waste tipping fees at the John Smith Road Landfill be considered for a decrease per the following:

Franchise ("Packer"): decrease from \$44.75 per ton to \$23.00 per ton

Public Refuse: decrease from \$62.75 per ton to \$46.00 per ton

Roll Off Refuse: decrease from \$57.00 per ton to \$46.00 per ton

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Benito that it hereby adopts the revised In-County waste tipping fee rates reflected in this Resolution effective July 1, 2018.
