7	WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5,		
8	Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April		
9	2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide;		
10	and		
11	WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the		
12	residents of our County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and		
13	which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and		
14	WHEREAS, the County must include a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the		
15	Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, in the County budget,		
16	which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule		
17	for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and		
18	WHEREAS, the County, has adopted RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2017-18 by Resolution 2017-		
19	105 in the estimated amount of \$700,893.00 from SB 1; and		
20	WHEREAS, the County, will receive an estimated \$1,781,706.00 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year		
21	2018-19 from SB 1; and		
22	WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to		
23	ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also		
24	meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and		
25	WHEREAS, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found tha		
26	the County's streets and roads are in a "poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase		
27	the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads		
28	into an "at risk" condition; and		

1	WHEREAS, modernizing the local street and road system provides well-paying construction jobs		
2	and boosts local economies; and		
3	WHEREAS, the local street and road system is also critical for farm to market needs,		
4	interconnectivity, multimodal needs, and commerce; and		
5	WHEREAS, police, fire, and emergency medical services all need safe reliable roads to react		
6	quickly to emergency calls and a few minutes of delay can be a matter of life and death; and		
7	WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads		
8	infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets		
9	infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant		
10	positive co-benefits statewide.
