8 **WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5,
9 Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April
10 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide;
11 and

12 **WHEREAS**, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the
13 residents of our County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and
14 which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the County must include a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the
16 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, in the County budget,
17 which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule
18 for the project’s completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the County, has adopted RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2017-18 by Resolution 2017-
20 105 in the estimated amount of \$700,893.00 from SB 1; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the County, will receive an estimated \$1,781,706.00 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year
22 2018-19 from SB 1; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to
24 ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also
25 meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that
27 the County’s streets and roads are in a “poor” condition and this revenue will help us increase
28 the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads
into an “at risk” condition; and

1 **WHEREAS**, modernizing the local street and road system provides well-paying construction jobs
2 and boosts local economies; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the local street and road system is also critical for farm to market needs,
4 interconnectivity, multimodal needs, and commerce; and

5 **WHEREAS**, police, fire, and emergency medical services all need safe reliable roads to react
6 quickly to emergency calls and a few minutes of delay can be a matter of life and death; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads
8 infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets
9 infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant
10 positive co-benefits statewide.

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San
13 Benito that,

- 14 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
15 2. The County's budget for fiscal year 2018-19 shall incorporate the planned list of road
16 improvement projects as shown in Exhibit A: List of Projects. These projects are to be
17 funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues. (See Exhibit A for
18 List of Projects.)
