8	Legislature have recognized the critical need for funding at the local level to combat homelessness; and		
9	WHEREAS, The Governor, Legislature, and San Benito County recognize the		
10	need for outreach and treatment to those who are living with a severe mental illness who are also homeless or at risk of homelessness, or who have had recent involvement with the criminal justice system or release from incarceration, as well		
11			
12	as other special populations within the county;		
13	WHEREAS, The Governor and Legislature have allocated \$50 million dollars in		
14	one-time funding for Fiscal Year 2018-19 to counties and four eligible cities for the Homeless Mentally Ill Outreach and Treatment allocation;		
15	WHEREAS, The Governor and Legislature have directed counties to leverage		
16	other available funding for this purpose and prohibited any supplantation of		
17	existing funding or services in order to maximize the impact of Homeless Mentally Ill Outreach and Treatment allocation dollars locally;		
18	WHEREAS, The Governor and Legislature require counties that receive Homeless		
19			
20	later than June 30, 2020, and further require counties to report to the Department		
21	of Health Care Services the disposition of funds, the services provided, and the number of individuals who received services no later than 90 days after the full expenditure of funding;		
22			
23	WHEREAS, The County of San Benito designates the County Behavioral Health Director as the single point of contact to the Department of Health Care Services		
24	for the Homeless Mentally Ill Outreach and Treatment allocation;		
25	WHEREAS, the County of San Benito affirms the county's commitment to		
26	combatting homelessness and improving outreach and treatment for those living with severe mental illness in our communities pursuant to the provisions of SB 840 and the receipt of Homeless Mentally Ill Outreach and Treatment funding;
