

## 7.02.010 Findings, Purpose, Effect, Authority, and Policy

- ✓ Removed reference to Federal Guideline-Cole Memo
- ✓ Added language regarding intent to regulate Adult-Use

#### 7.02.020 Definitions

- Removed reference to medical only definitions
- ✓ Enforcement Officer
- ✓ Greenhouse
- ✓ Youth Center





#### 7.02.030 Prohibited Activities

- Retail establishments
- ✓ Non-Storefront operations
- Microbusiness-with retail activities of any nature

## 7.02.040 Cannabis Permit Required

- ✓ Permits will be issued by County Administrative Officer or his/her designee
- ✓ No other substantial changes





## 7.02.050 Cannabis Business Regulatory Program

- Application forms will establish minimum standards
- Creates a merit based scoring process for permits which are limited

## 7.02.060 Cannabis Permit Types

- ✓ Distribution facilities
- ✓ Indoor cultivation-Includes greenhouses
- ✓ Manufacturing Type 6 & Type 7 changes





## 7.02.060 Cannabis Permit Types (Cont'd)

- ✓ Microbusiness-(Non-Retail)
- ✓ Testing Labs

## 7.02.070 Cannabis Permit Application

- Adding language authorizing background check
- ✓ Updated Initial Application/Renewal due dates
- ✓ Number of Permits
  - ✓ Cultivation-Limited to 50
  - Distribution-Unlimited
  - Manufacturing-Unlimited
  - ✓ Testing-Unlimited
  - ✓ Test-Unlimited





#### 7.02.080 Restrictions

- ✓ Boundary line set back (300)
- ✓ Buffer distance for sensitive uses (1,000)
- ✓ Residence Set Back (400)
- ✓ Cultivation can only occur on property ten (10) acres or more
- ✓ If cultivation is on property less than 10 acres it will require a hearing process
- Cultivation can also occur on commercial property

### 7.02.090 Grounds for Denial

✓ Changed applicant eligibility from 18 to 21 years of age





## 7.02.100 Procedure for Suspension or Revocation

✓ No substantial changes

## 7.02.110 Cannabis Business Facilities

- Changed transport permit to distributor permit
- Added manufacturing permit requirements
- ✓ Added testing lab requirements





#### 7.02.120 Records

✓ No substantial changes

## 7.02.130 Promulgation of Regulations, Standards, and Other Legal Duties

- Replaced previous language that reference passage of tax measure
- CAO authorized to make additional rules, regulations and standards
- Creates procedures for oversight
- ✓ Allows for update to regulations due to state law changes
