SUBJECT: Appointments to San Benito Resource Conservation District Board of Directors

#### **SUMMARY:**

Regularly scheduled vacancies due to expiration of terms requires appointment of Directors to the San Benito Resource Conservation District by the San Benito County Board of Supervisors pursuant to resolution 2006-1 passed, adopted and presented to San Benito County on Aug. 4, 2006. Three Director's terms expire on the last Friday of November 2018.
