17 18 19	WHEREAS, the minimum income generation requirements are \$3,500 annual gross income from the sale of agricultural commodities, produced for three (3) out of every immediately preceding five (5) consecutive year period, absent an act of God, such as an extended drought, which prevents the achievement of this standard, pursuant to County Code section 19.01.021(D)(1)(b); and
202122	WHEREAS, the owners of agricultural preserves, comprising approximately 505.98+ acres and 77.63+ acres of land under agricultural preserve Contract Numbers 11-02 and 11-03, currently operated as a vineyard, requested a division and reallocation of the existing preserve into two (2) new preserves, to be comprised of approximately 40+ acres and 543.61+ acres, respectively, and reported annual gross incomes in excess of \$3,500 per year for each of the new preserves; and
