A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN BENITO ESTABLISHING A COUNTY TREASURY OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Resolution No. 96-21

WHEREAS, the State Legislature by adoption of SB 866 has imposed new statutory requirements applicable to the investment of County funds; and

WHEREAS, one of these new statutory requirements mandate the establishment of a county treasury oversight committee if the county is investing surplus funds; and

WHEREAS, San Benito County invests the surplus funds in its county treasury; and WHEREAS, the San Benito County Treasurer/Tax Collector/Public Administrator has consulted with the Board of Supervisors by way of oral comment and written documentation;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the San Benito County Board of Supervisors that hereby establishes the San Benito County Treasury Oversight Committee composed of four (4) members to be constituted as follows:

- (1) The Clerk/Auditor/Recorder,
- (2) A representative of the San Benito County Board of Supervisors,
- (3) The County Superintendent of Schools, or his designee,
- (4) A representative selected by a majority of the presiding officers of the governing bodies of the school districts and community college districts in the county.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ADDITIONALLY RESOLVED that the San Benito County Board of Supervisors appoints the following persons to the San Benito County Treasury Oversight Committee, which persons shall serve at the pleasure of the board for one (1) year and at the pleasure of the body created by statute as the designated or selecting body:

- John R. Hodges, as the Clerk/Auditor/Recorder, (1)
- (2) Ron Rodrigues, as the representative of the San Benito County Board of Supervisors,
 - (3)Dick Lowry, as the County Superintendent of Schools,
- (4) Dean Bubar, as the representative selected by a majority of the presiding officers of the governing bodies of the school districts and community college districts in the county.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Benito County Treasury Oversight Committee shall meet as necessary in compliance with the Brown Act (Govt. Code § 54950 et seg.) in order to discharge its statutory duties as further described in Article 6 (commencing with section 27130) of Division 2 of Title 3 of the Government Code.
