7	WHEREAS, the County of San Benito abandoned the Old Stage Road and converted the abandoned road to a County Recreational Trail in 1998; and
9	WHEREAS, the Recreational Trail was the first public-private partnership parks project in

10	WHEREAS, the Recreational Trail was named the "Anza Trail", after Juan Bautista de A whose expedition came from the Monterey County side of the trail, and then veered toward the Juan Canyon due to the steep incline; and

13 14	WHEREAS, in 1999, the County of San Benito and the National Park Service entered into an agreement to mutually support the historic and economic value of designating this part of the County Recreational Trial as the "Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail"; and
15	WHEREAS, under condition of the neighboring landowners, should the Recreational Trail abandoned by the County, all lands will be restored to the neighboring landowners; and

17 18	WHEREAS, under condition of the right-of-way grant, the County of San Benito must traverse the Recreational Trail/Old Stage Road at least once a year; and
19	WHEREAS, Mr. James Rockwell West (Jim West) was dedicated to public service in the Count of San Benito, holding many appointed and elected public offices, most recently as the Mayor of the City of San Juan Bautista; and

21	WHEREAS, Jim West was one of the original Commissioners appointed to the San Benito Count Parks and Recreation Commission; and

23	WHEREAS, as a Parks and Recreation Commissioner, Jim West worked on the San Benito Count Parks and Recreation Facilities Master Plan; and

25	WHEREAS, Jim West organized the " <i>Tiffany Tour</i> ", consisting of 120 antique vehicles traversing the Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail, on Saturday, May 7, 2011, to celebrate the 100 year of the first Ford dealership in California, Tiffany Ford in Hollister, California; and

27	WHEREAS , since 2011, the annual tour of antique vehicles has continued on the second Saturday in May.
