**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN BENITO ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Subsection (D) of Section 3.03.007 “Appointment” of Chapter 3.03 “Personnel” of Title 3 “Administration and Personnel” of the San Benito County Code shall be amended to read as follows:

(D) All other department heads shall be appointed by the County Administrative Officer. Department head positions shall be established by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 2. Subsection (H) of Section 3.01.092 “Duties and Responsibilities” of Article VI “County Administrative Officer” of Chapter 3.01 “Administration Generally” of Title 3 “Administration and Personnel” of the San Benito County Code shall be amended to read as follows:

(H) Appoint and supervise those department heads as set forth in subsection (D) of 3.03.007.

SECTION 3:

A. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, portion, or phrase of this chapter is for any reason held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. The board hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, portion, or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared illegal, invalid or unconstitutional.

B. Codification. Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance shall be codified. The remaining sections shall not be codified.

C. Captions. The titles and headings of this ordinance and the sections hereunder are not part of this ordinance and shall have no effect upon the construction or interpretation of any part thereof.

D. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective sixty (30) days after adoption. Prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the adoption thereof shall be published at least one time in a newspaper of general circulation in San Benito County, with the names of the Supervisors voting for or against the same.
