Introduction

The application review and selection processes are typically the most onerous and difficult portions of a successful municipal cannabis implementation, especially pertaining to a competitive selection process for a finite number of licenses. SCI currently provides these services for the Cities of West Hollywood Lompoc, Colfax, Dunsmuir, San Carlos, and Nevada City.

SCI understands that the County of San Benito has an established a four-phase process for application review, ranking, and selection and has established regulatory fees to reimburse the County for this review. SCI's scope for this task includes supporting the selection process to identify the optimal cannabis applicants for the County, based upon the process and criteria established by the County.

• Phase 2: Application Evaluation and Initial Ranking:

SCI will evaluate and rank all applications based on the specific criteria established for Phase 2 and for compliance with the County and State regulations. A scoring spreadsheet will be provided to the County identifying the applicants which have passed Phase 2 with at least an 80% or higher scoring.

In addition, SCI will prepare the County's Selection Committee for the interviews and develop a document outlining the Phase 3 interviews, including interview questions.

Compensation for Services as described in the Scope of Work shall be charged hourly based upon the rates in the table below not to exceed \$3,000 per application without approval from the County.

Incidental costs incurred by SCI for the purchase of travel and other out-of-pocket expenses will be reimbursed at actual cost, with the total not to exceed \$2,500 without prior authorization from the County.

The scope of services includes one face-to-face staff planning meeting. Any additional meetings, if required, shall be billed at the rate of \$1,050 per person, per meeting.
