5 **LIKE HOME PROGRAM)**

6 **WHEREAS**, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community
7 Development (HCD) initially issued a Notice of Funding Availability, dated
8 August 15, 2018 as amended on October 30, 2018, under the No Place Like Home
9 Program (NPLH) authorized by Government Code section 15463, Part 3.9 of
10 Division 5 (commencing with Section 5849.1) of the Welfare and Institutions
11 Code, and Welfare and Institutions Code section 5890;

12 **WHEREAS**, the Notice of Funding Application (NOFA) relates to the
13 availability for San Benito County of approximately \$732,713 in Noncompetitive
14 Allocation funds under the NPLH Program; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the County of San Benito ("County") is an Applicant within the
16 meaning of Section 101(c) of the NPLH Program Guidelines, dated July 17, 2017.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE**
18 **COUNTY OF SAN BENITO RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

19 **SECTION 1.** That County Behavioral Health Department is hereby
20 authorized and directed to apply for and accept the NPLH Program funds, as
21 detailed in the NOFA up to the amount authorized by Section 102 of the
22 Guidelines and applicable state law.

23 **SECTION 2.** That County Behavioral Health Director, is hereby authorized
24 and directed to act on behalf of County in connection with the NPLH
25 Noncompetitive Allocation award, and to enter into, execute, and deliver a State of
26 California Standard Agreement ("Standard Agreement"), a regulatory agreement, a
27 promissory note, a deed of trust and security agreement, and any and all other
28 documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate as security for, evidence
29 of, or pertaining to the NPLH Program funds, and all amendments thereto
30 (collectively, the "NPLH Program Documents").

31 **SECTION 3.** That County shall be subject to the terms and conditions that
32 are specified in the Standard Agreement; that the application in full is incorporated
33 as part of the Standard Agreement; that any and all activities funded, information
34 provided, and timelines represented in the application are enforceable through the
35 Standard Agreement; and that County will use the NPLH Program funds in
36 accordance with the Guidelines, other applicable rules and laws, the NPLH
37 Program Documents, and any and all NPLH Program requirements.

1 SECTION 4. That County Behavioral Health Department will make mental
2 health supportive services available to the project's NPLH tenants for at least 20
3 years, and will coordinate the provision of, or referral to, other services (including,
4 but not limited to, substance use services) in accordance with the County's
relevant supportive services plan in accordance with Welfare and Institutions Code
section 5849.9(a).
