WHEREAS, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) initially issued a Notice of Funding Availability, dated August 15, 2018 as amended on October 30, 2018, under the No Place Like Home Program (NPLH) authorized by Government Code section 15463, Part 3. 9 of Division 5 (commencing with Section 5849.1) of the Welfare and Institutions Code, and Welfare and Institutions Code section 5890;

WHEREAS, the Notice of Funding Application (NOFA) relates to the availability for San Benito County of approximately \$732,713 in Noncompetitive Allocation funds under the NPLH Program; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Benito ("County") is a County and an Applicant as those terms are defined in the NPLH Program Guidelines, dated July 17, 2017 ("Guidelines"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on May 21, 2019 adopted Resolution No. 2019-44 accepting the County of San Benito noncompetitive allocation award under the No Place Like Home Program; and

WHEREAS, HCD has determined that there is a need to amend Resolution No. 2019-44 Section 4 to include verbiage for non-competitive NPLH projects funded under Article II of the Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 2019-44 is hereby restated and amended in its entirety:

SECTION 1. That County is hereby authorized and directed to apply for and accept the NPLH Program funds, as detailed in the NOFA up to the amount authorized by Section 102 of the Guidelines and applicable state law.

SECTION 2. That County Behavioral Health Director, is hereby authorized and directed to act on behalf of County in connection with the NPLH Noncompetitive Allocation award, and to enter into, execute, and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement ("Standard Agreement"), a regulatory agreement, a promissory note, a deed of trust and security agreement, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate as security for, evidence of, or pertaining to the NPLH Program funds, and all amendments thereto (collectively, the "NPLH Program Documents").
