A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN BENITO
COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
ACCEPTING THE ANNUAL REPORT FOR
CSA #36 AND ESTABLISHING BENEFIT
ASSESSMENT CHARGES FOR EACH
PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY FOR CSA #36
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND
ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT

Resolution No. 2019-____

WHEREAS, County Service Area #36 was originally established and continues to be maintained for the purpose of raising revenues to support Advanced Life Support (paramedics) and an Emergency Medical Services system in the incorporated and unincorporated portions of San Benito County established by Resolution No. 90-124; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the provision of Emergency Medical Services and Advanced Life Support services is in the best interest of the public health, safety and general welfare of the County; and

WHEREAS, former California Government Code §25210.77a, given continuing effect through Government Code §25210.3(d) provides San Benito County with a mechanism to continue these services; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2019, the San Benito County Emergency Medical Services Agency filed a report with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for County Service Area #36 and requested a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2019, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors set a public hearing to hear objections or protests and consider the report; and

WHEREAS, notice was published in accordance with Government Code Section 6066 in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published within the County of San Benito; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors held the duly noticed public hearing at its regular meeting of July 23, 2019, at which time it heard and received all oral and written testimony and evidence that was made, presented or filed, and all persons present at the

hearing were given the opportunity to hear and be heard with respect to any matter related thereto; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the public testimony, and in accordance with all applicable state and local law, the Board of Supervisors closed the public hearing and deliberated and considered the annual report and benefit assessment charges contained therein, together with all objections or protests received, in light of all evidence in the record.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that based on the oral and documentary evidence, including the San Benito County Emergency Medical Services Agency's annual report for County Service Area #36 Emergency Medical Services and Advanced Life Support Services, offered and received at the public hearing, the Board expressly finds and determines that:

- 1) the above recitals are true and correct;
- 2) the Board of Supervisors adopted benefit assessment charges of \$20.00 per Benefit Assessment Unit (BAU) for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, and the annual report supports retaining benefit assessment charges in the amount of \$20.00 per BAU;
- 3) the benefit assessment charges are levied without regard to property valuation;
- 4) each of the several lots and parcels of land subject to the benefit assessment charges will be specially benefited by the services to be financed by the benefit assessment charge proceeds in at least the amount of the benefit assessment charges apportioned against such lots and parcels of land, respectively
- 5) there is substantial evidence to support, and the weight of the evidence preponderates in favor of, said finding and determination as to special benefit to property from the services to be financed with benefit assessment charge proceeds, as described in the annual report; and
- 6) the public interest, convenience and necessity require that the levy of benefit assessment charges be made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors hereby accepts the annual report and adopts the benefit assessment charges of \$20.00 per BAU.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that no later than the second Monday in August following such adoption, the Board of Supervisors shall file a certified copy of the benefit assessment charges and a certified copy of this resolution with the San Benito County Auditor ("County Auditor"). Upon such filing, the County Officer(s) shall enter on the County assessment roll opposite each lot or parcel of land the amount of the benefit assessment charges. The benefit assessment charges shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as County taxes are collected and all the laws providing for collection and enforcement of County taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of the benefit assessment charges. After collection by the County, the net amount of the benefit assessment charges, after deduction of any compensation due the County for collection, shall be paid to and deposited into a separate fund established under the distinctive designation of CSA #36, to be expended only for the special benefit of parcels within CSA #36.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the benefit assessment charges, as applied to any parcel, may be corrected, cancelled or a refund granted, as appropriate, by order of the Board of Supervisors. Any such corrections, cancellations or refunds shall be limited to the current fiscal year.
