Appointment of Associate Director to the San Benito Resource Conservation District by the San Benito County Board of Supervisors pursuant to resolution 2019-1 passed, adopted and presented to the County on Aug. 4, 2006. A new associate director has been recommended for appointment by SBRCD Board of Directors per Res. No. 2019-2.

Vacancy Notices were posted and published pursuant to our bylaws and Section 54974 of the Government Code. Applications were reviewed.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is respectfully requested that the Board of Supervisors:

Approve the appointment of John Nolan as Associate Director of the San Benito Resource Conservation District for a term to expire the last Friday of November 2022.

DISCUSSION:

According to our bylaws, Directors shall serve four-year terms. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment only for the Associate Director. Therefore, we request that John Nolan be appointed for a full term of four years, but that his term will expire prior to four-years time.

Whereas, John Nolan is committed to resource conservation and management in San Benito County.


Whereas, John Nolan would help to expand the breadth of the San Benito Resource Conservation District programs to include non-agricultural residents.




