


San Benito County Opioid Task Force Update

In, 2017 San Benito County had the 12th highest opioid overdose death rate in the state (trailing SF).










Established September 2017 and grown to over 50 members

opioid overdose reversing medication











PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

The California Opioid Safety Network (COSN) supports a statewide forum of peer-to-peer learning for coalitions mounting a local response to the opioid epidemic in California. VISTA volunteers support the work of these multi-sector teams to bolster impact through robust social media presence, project coordination, data analysis, and more.

WHERE VISTAS SERVE

VISTAs are placed in counties across the state of California covering 85% of the population. They work to build the capacity of coalitions by strengthening their structure and

40 COSN VISTA members are 21+ years old. Most have bachelors or masters degrees with a health focus, and diverse work experience.



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT



VISTAs participate in monthly Learning
Network webinars and topic-specific discussions covering: capacity building, managing up, strategic communications and storytelling, stigma and harm reduction, youth engagement, and more.

NETWORKING & SUPPORT

COSN VISTA leaders conduct quarterly 1-on-1 check in calls to provide individualized support. Geographic cluster calls connect VISTAs working in similar areas. A VISTA discussion hub and resources are provided on the COSN website

VISTA stands for Volunteer In Service To America, and is a national service year.




