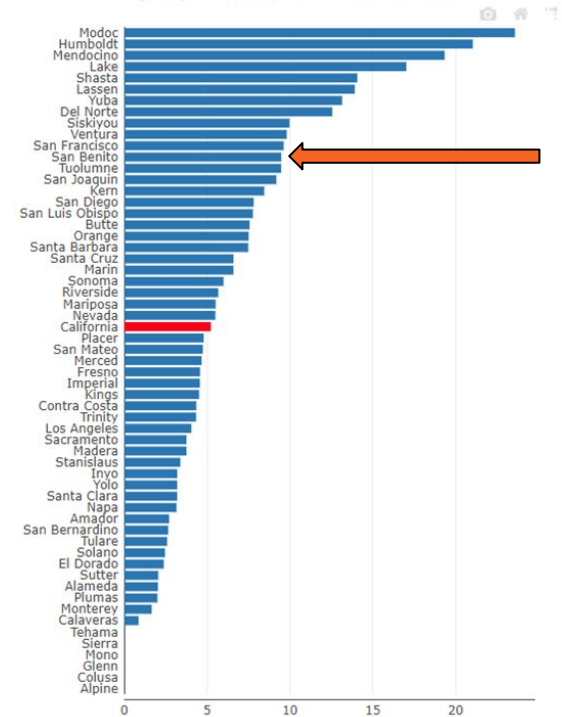




San Benito County Opioid Task Force Update

Strength in partnerships throughout the community, more access to hard to reach populations

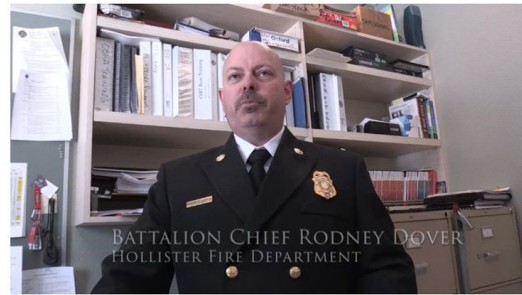

CALIFORNIA OPIOID SAFETY NETWORK AMERICORPS VISTA PROGRAM



PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

The California Opioid Safety Network (COSN) supports a statewide forum of peer-to-peer learning for coalitions mounting a local response to the opioid epidemic in California. VISTA volunteers support the work of these multi-sector teams to bolster impact through robust social media presence, project coordination, data analysis, and more.

WHERE VISTAS SERVE



VISTAs are placed in counties across the state of California covering 85% of the population. They work to build the capacity of coalitions by strengthening their structure and broadening their network.

WHO SERVES

40 COSN VISTA members are 21+ years old. Most have bachelors or masters degrees with a health focus, and diverse work experience.



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT



VISTAs participate in monthly Learning Network webinars and topic-specific discussions covering: capacity building, managing up, strategic communications and storytelling, stigma and harm reduction, youth engagement, and more.

NETWORKING & SUPPORT

COSN VISTA leaders conduct quarterly 1-on-1 check in calls to provide individualized support. Geographic cluster calls connect VISTAs working in similar areas. A VISTA discussion hub and resources are provided on the COSN website

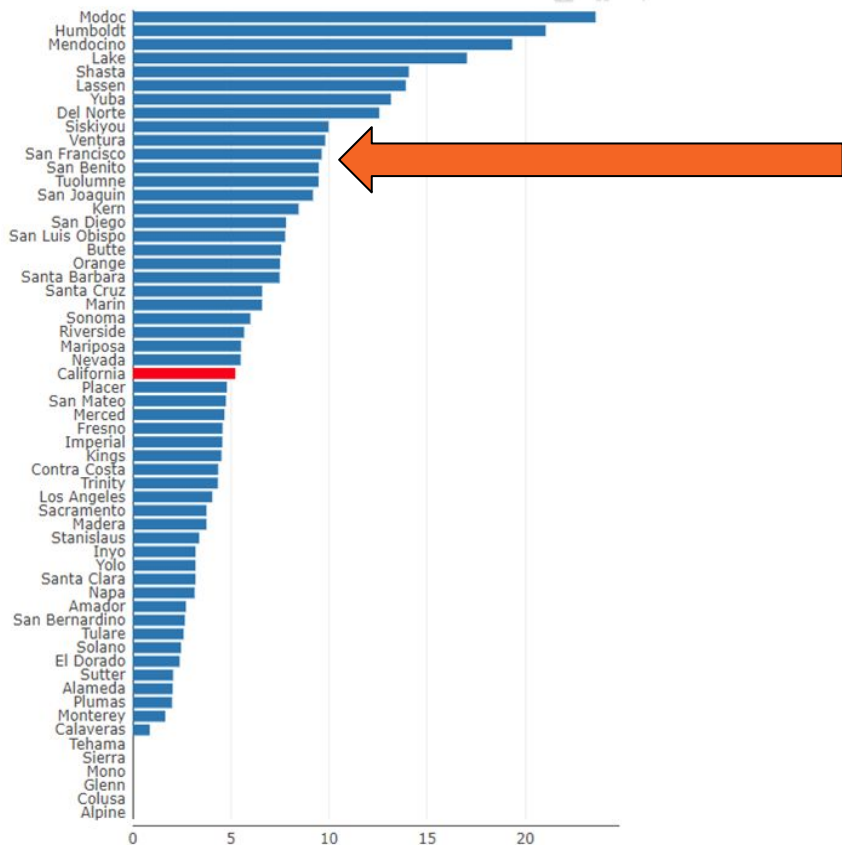

Any Opioid-Related Overdose Deaths - Total Population, 2017

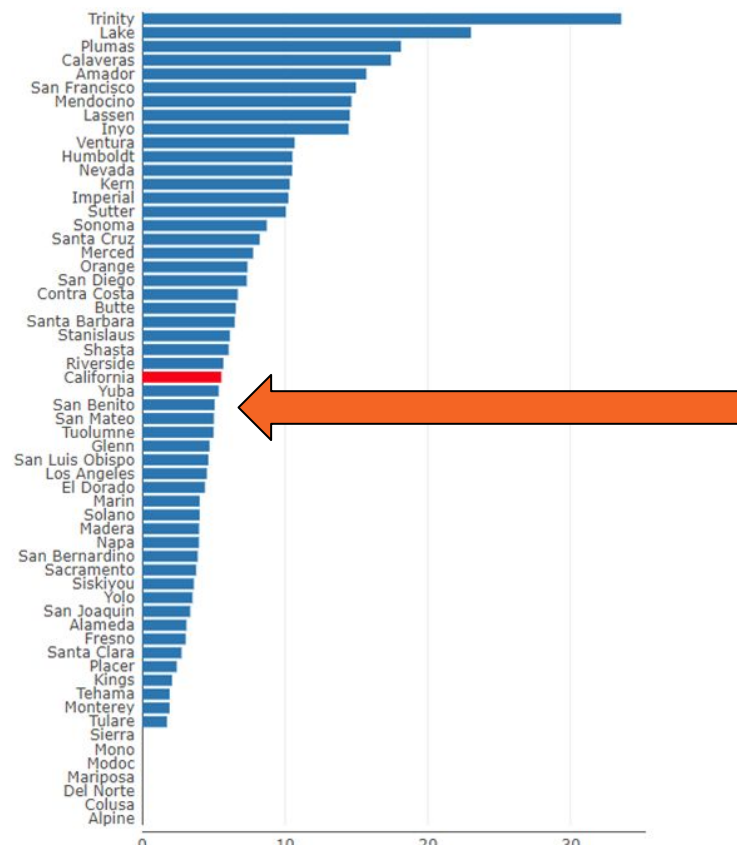
Age-Adjusted Rate per 100,000 Residents

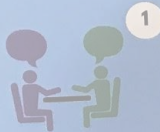
