Pursuant to Section 9.03 of the Agreement to Provide Advanced Life Support Ambulance Service to the County of San Benito, American Medical Response is formally requesting an annual rate increase. Under the terms of the Agreement with rate increase calculations provided under Section 9.3 A, we are seeking a 20.3 percent increase to keep pace with rising operational costs and the fiscal dynamics in collections.

The increase will allow us to remain fiscally stable as we continue to make system enhancements that will translate to improving the services to the public. This also helps continue supporting the new wage schedules included for our field staff and takes into account the annual subsidy.

We are available to discuss with you in greater detail the assumptions made to necessitate the rate increase. Thank you for your consideration.
