- Just fill out and file forms
- All Veterans can use the VA for healthcare
- Only help Veterans with disabilities
- Only help Veterans with accessing VA health care
- Only help Veterans
- One visit is all it takes

Our office develops solid cases to submit to the VA and advocate for the Veteran, their spouse and dependents to obtain Federal and State Benefits. This process can take multiple visits and appeals before getting a satisfactory decision. We help veterans and their families access a wide range of benefits such as Health Care and Disability Compensation as well as Educational and Surviving Spouse Benefits

California Military & Veterans Code Section 970.

- (a)The board of supervisors of each county may appoint, prescribe the qualifications of, and fix the compensation of an officer to be titled "county veterans service officer." The appointee shall be a veteran.
- (b)It shall be the duty of the county veterans service officer to administer the aid provided for in this chapter, to investigate all claims, applications, or requests for aid made pursuant to the terms of this chapter, and to perform any other veteran related services as requested by the county board of supervisors.
- (c)Notwithstanding subdivision (a), <u>two or more counties may jointly</u> <u>establish a single veterans service office</u> which shall serve all the counties that agree to the joint establishment of that office.





- Administer Aid connect veterans with VA programs for housing, education, and healthcare
- Investigate Claims file claims for VA Pension and Compensation Benefits and Death Benefits
- **Perform Services** outreach and referral services to veteran service organizations
